



Direct Support Program Eligibility & Policies

At the Hughes Family & Friends Foundation, we understand that unexpected hardships can place tremendous strain on families. Our Direct Support Program is designed to provide temporary assistance to eligible Utah parents, guardians, caregivers, and teachers who are supporting children under 18. To ensure our limited resources are distributed fairly and consistently, all applications are reviewed according to the eligibility requirements and program policies below.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a Utah resident.
- Must be a parent, legal guardian, caregiver, or teacher supporting a child under 18.
- Must be experiencing financial hardship.
- Must provide all required documentation and accurate information.

Program Policies

- Assistance is generally limited to one instance of assistance per household.
- Only one household member is eligible to receive assistance.
- Assistance is subject to available funding and is not guaranteed.
- The Hughes Family & Friends Foundation determines the type and amount of assistance provided.
- Additional documentation or verification may be requested.
- Submission of an application does not guarantee approval.
- The Hughes Family & Friends Foundation reserves the right to deny any application that does not meet program guidelines.
- Providing false or misleading information may result in the denial of current and future assistance.
